Halikarnassos after Alexander the Great - a deserted city?

Wednesday 20 March at 7 p.m. at the Danish Institute



According to the ancient authors, Halikarnassos was razed to the ground by Alexander the Great and was claimed to be an almost deserted and ruined city during the Imperial period and later. This biased representation of the history and urban development of Halikarnassos after 334 BC cannot be maintained when taking into account the evidence of other sources such as the epigraphic, numismatic, and archaeological material, and the city certainly had a second 'golden age' during Late Antiquity
